### **POLICY DESCRIPTION:**

Being a policy to allow access to the Forrest Water Treatment Plan for required daily testing during inclement weather within the Rural Municipality of Elton (Elton) where Ralph Berg is the Utility Operator for Elton.

- Whitehead Elton Regional Water Co-operative Manager (Manager) or Utility Operator (Utility Operator) shall contact Elton Public Works (PW) to request emergency access to Forrest WTP.
- Elton PW will place priority to plow Walker Avenue in Forrest to the Forrest WTP, then Elton Road to PR 468 and then north on PR 468 to Ralph Berg in Justice.
- Elton PW shall ensure that this access is opened on a priority basis whether or not the Manager or Utility Operator has notified Elton PW.

Manitoba Infrastructure (MI) has given approval for Elton to plow on PR 468 in December 2016. The Elton insurance policy shall maintain coverage for work completed on MI roads.
