

POLICY DESCRIPTION:

Be it resolved that Council of the RM of Elton adopt the following policy for snow removal on Municipal Sidewalks and Backlanes in Villages.

- Snow will **NOT** be removed from Municipal sidewalks or backlanes by the municipality. It is encouraged that residents be "Good Neighbours" and clear the sidewalk adjacent to their property to make walking safer for yourself and your neighbours.
- It shall be an offense for any person to remove from any private property, municipal property, street, or sidewalk any snow or ice and deposit same on any street, sidewalk, or public property in such a manner that could create a hazardous condition for either vehicular or pedestrian traffic. If this is to occur, registered written notice will be provided as follows:
 - A copy of this policy.
 - Notice that for second and subsequent offences, billing for removal of snow from the municipal road, sidewalk, backlane or any public property that originated from their property will be charged at the rate in effect at the time of the offence.
 - Advice that only one notice per property will be issued. This one notice shall apply for all subsequent years wherein any additional notice will be deemed a second or subsequent offence and shall be subject to the billing charge.
 - Notice that, following issuance of first notice, any damages caused by the snow being left on municipal road, sidewalk, backlane, or any public property to municipal equipment and/or injury to municipal employees will be billed to the ratepayer and collectible in the same manner as property tax may be collected or enforced under the Municipal Act.
