## Municipal Minutes

### June 1<sup>st</sup> Special Meeting & June 13, 2017 Regular Meeting

#### June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 Special Meeting:

Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, & Reeve Farley attended. A waterline connection request was approved on NW ¼ 29-12-17 WPM. Approval was given for the installation of a stainless steel header in the Forrest Water Treatment Plant. Bluestar Construction was awarded the tender for claycapping 1 mile on Humesville Road in the approximate amount of \$67,000.00. An application was submitted under the Municipal Road and Bridge Program to cost share 2017 Capital Road Projects as follows: Wheatbelt Road Upgrades for \$74,124.07, Humesville Road Upgrades for an estimated cost of \$67,000.00 and Gourlay Road Upgrades for a cost of \$18,511.50. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> readings were given to By-Law No. 1576 (Farthing Development Agmt). 1<sup>st</sup> readings were given to By-Law No. 1577 (Boyd Easement Agmt), By-Law No. 1578 (Waywayseecappo MSA) & By-Law No. 1579 (Deer Ridge/Kading Agmt). Burns Maendel was given approval to complete Forrest drainage licensing in the amount of \$10,250.00. **June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Regular Meeting:** Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, Kowbel & Reeve Farley attended. The minutes

of the regular meeting held on May 9<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 were approved. 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading of By-Law No. 1576 was given (Farthing Agmt). 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> readings to By-Law No. 1577 (Boyd Easement Agmt), By-Law No. 1578 (Waywayseecappo Agmt), and By-Law No. 1579 (Deer Ridge/Kading Agmt) were given. By-Law No. 1580 (Cleaver) was given 1<sup>st</sup> reading. Conditional Use Order No. C-03-17-E (Campbell) on SE ¼ 11-11-18 WPM was approved. Financial statements for the months ended April 30 and May 31, 2017 were filed. PureSphera was contracted to collect old refrigeration units from the collection site at Forrest. Sarah-Jane Speers was contracted for elevations across the Municipality. Policies No. 35-2013 (Dust Control) & No. 7-2012 (Signs) were revised. Authorization was given to CAO to donate archival records to Archives of Manitoba. Tenders were awarded for Douglas Sidewalks to Gaiser Construction for \$34,230.00 plus tax & Ward 1 Shrub Removal to Busy Beaver for \$2,500.00. Accounts of \$219,206.31 were approved. The meeting adjourned to Tues., July 11, 2017 at 9:00 am.

### Signs Policy No. 7-2012

**POLICY DESCRIPTON:** Erection of signs is permitted in the Rural Municipality of Elton in the following circumstances:

- Sign must be approved by Ward Councillor.
- Sign must be located so as not to interfere with maintenance & snow clearance of roads.
- The municipality does not assume any responsibility or liability for maintenance, repair or replacement of the sign at any time.
- All costs for signs and labour are the responsibility of the person requesting the sign.

## Dust Control Policy No. 35-2013

**POLICY DESCRIPTON:** Be it resolved that Council of the RM of Elton (Elton) amend the dust control policy on municipal roads effective June 13, 2017 as follows:

- Residents/ratepayers will be responsible to arrange for application of dust control at their property.
- Residents/ratepayers must apply to the Elton Municipal Office for approval to apply dust control on the roadway by their property a minimum of 1 week (5 working days) prior to product being applied to allow for prepping the site each year;
- Approved dust control products are Calcium Chloride and Magnesium Chloride. A request for approval of any other dust control suppressant must be approved by Council at a Council meeting each year;
- Application site must be identified by stakes by the resident/ratepayer at the time of request;
- The resident/ratepayer is responsible for all costs for dust control product/application;
- Approval for application of dust control may be delayed beyond the 1 week (5 working days) notice period if Elton cannot access materials to properly prepare the site to ensure road safety;

**The municipality reserves the right to grade all dust control sites to maintain safe road surfaces throughout the year.**
