Municipal Minutes

Regular Meeting, May 8, 2018

Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, and Reeve Farley attended. Financial statement for the month ending April 30, 2018 was accepted and filed. A public hearing was held for Subdivision application 4124-18-663 for McPhail Farms Ltd on NW ¼ 6-11-18 to subdivide twenty lots and create a public road and Council approved said subdivision subject to conditions. Quote to purchase seed for the Municipal ¼ on SW 31-11-18 was awarded to Bollman Seeds for a cost of \$488.41 to seed 13 acres (Councillor Bollman was excused due to a conflict). Chemical quote to spray Municipal ditches was awarded to Shur-Gro. The Municipal spray trailer was sold to Joel Warkentin for bid of \$2,500.00. Office Parging quote was awarded to Doug Husluk in the amount of \$2,500.00. The purchase of branded outerwear for Public Works Staff was approved. Reeve Farley, Councillors Mitchell & Campbell, and CAO were authorized to attend the 2018 AMM District Meetings in Pierson, MB. Councillors Campbell, Bollman, Hales and PW Foreman Gord Stinson were approved to attend the

2018 Western District Best Ball Tournament in Deloraine. Funding was requested from the MWSB & Sewer Program for Forrest/Douglas Lagoon development & expansion. Approval was given to the draft Boundary Road Agreement with RM of Oakview. CAO was authorized to attend the Capital Asset Management Plan Seminar on May 9, 2018 in Brandon. Policy No. 35-2018 (Dust Control) was amended. Staff overtime for the month of April was approved. Vertex was granted temporary road and approach access for work on TransCanada Pipeline Ltd. From May 15 – December 31, 2018. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$621,937.62. A public hearing for Conditional Use Application C-02-18-E for Harvey Paterson on Pt. SE 36-11-19 to establish a non-farm dwelling in the "AG80" zone and was approved by Council (Councillor Paterson was excused due to conflict). The meeting was adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at 9:00 am or at the call of the Reeve.
