Municipal Minutes

Regular Meeting, July 10, 2018 Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, and Reeve Farley attended. Financial statement for the month ending June 30, 2018 was accepted and filed. 3rd readings to BL 1565 (Animal Control) & BL 1595 (Oakview Boundary Road Agmt) were given and passed. 1st & 2nd reading were given to BL 1597 (MWM Environmental Recycling Agmt). 1st reading was given to BL 1599 (Minto-Odanah Boundary Road Agmt). Public Hearing for Conditional Use C0-03-18-E on Pt. NE 1/4 27-12-18 (Dunn) was held and approved to establish an event venue for hosting weddings, family reunions and corporate events as a home-based business. Submitted plans for Conditional Use No. C-03-18-B as presented by Keller Developments was approved subject to fencing being installed across the northern boundary of the parcel. Drainage requests on NE 1/4 21-11-17 and W 1/2 14-11-17 were approved. Policy 66-2018 (Animal By-Law Penalties) was approved. Douglas Road Reconstruction RFP was awarded to Bluestar Construction in the amount of \$139,000.00 and will be submitted for funding under the Municipal Road and Bridge Program in the amount of \$60,000.00. Culvert Installations, Road

Work & Ditch Clean out RFP's were awarded. Audited **Financial** Statements prepared by MNP for the year ended December 31, 2017 were approved as circulated. Paterson will be suppling new trees and watering the Forrest Green Space. The following was decided regarding a written request from Troy and Nancy Moorehead: Permission to shift south end of the road 5 feet to the west, ditch installations were approved subject to a license being obtained, road can be graded, grass trimmed and weeds sprayed provided no damage occurs & 40-foot approach may be installed on west side of road subject to license being obtained. All above approvals are at the cost of Moorehead. Letters will be sent out to everyone in the spray exclusion zones on the weed spraying map indicating that they must apply every year to be included in the "no spray zone". Staff overtime for the month ended June 30, 2018 was approved. Accounts in the amount \$209,096.71 was approved The meeting was presented. adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, August 14, 2018 at 9:00 am or at the call of the Reeve.
