Municipal Minutes

Regular Meeting, Sept. 11, 2018

Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, and Reeve Farley attended. Financial statement for the month ending August 31, 2018 was filed. Subdivision File No. 4124-18-676 on NE ¼ 19-12-18 (Phillips) was approved. Agreement with Riverdale Municipality was adopted and 1st reading to BL 1598 (Riverdale Boundary Road Agmt) was given. 2nd and 3rd readings to BL 1600 (Delinquent Water Accounts in Oakview) and BL 1601 (North Cypress Boundary Road Agmt) were given. Policy No. 67-2018 (Office Closure at Christmas) was approved as presented. Council authorized an annual operating grant of \$200.00 to Norman-Creeford Cairn committee. Approval was given to cost share brush/shrub removal on Boundary Road 72N with the RM of Oakview at a cost not to exceed \$1,102.50 (being 50%). RFP's to be sent out for a new camera system at the Douglas Waste Transfer Site. Advertisement in the Royal Canadian Legion Military Service Recognition Book at a cost of \$205.00 was approved. Authorization was given for Municipal Records to be filed with the Archives of Manitoba Government Records in Winnipeg and the disposal of Municipal

Records that are not required to be kept. An extension for Lot 7, Plan 55511 BLTO was approved provided monthly penalty continues to be paid until issuance of final occupancy permit. Councillor Bollman is authorized to attend Watershed District Meeting in Neepawa with expenses to be paid. Authorization was given to purchase burning ban signs to be placed around the Municipality during a burning ban. The regular council meeting in January 2019 is rescheduled for January 15, 2019. Authorization was given to Councillor Bollman, CAO Steele and Foreman Stinson to attend AMM Asset Management Workshop. Authorization was given to Norm Hodgson for mowing of small brush at an approximate cost of \$1,200.00. Notice of Motion to reconsider Resolution No. 2018-47 was given. Staff overtime to August 31, 2018 was approved. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$138,406.72 as per list of accounts presented to Council. Meeting was adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, October 9, 2018 at 9:00 am or at the call of the Reeve.
