Municipal Minutes

October 9, 2018 Regular Meeting

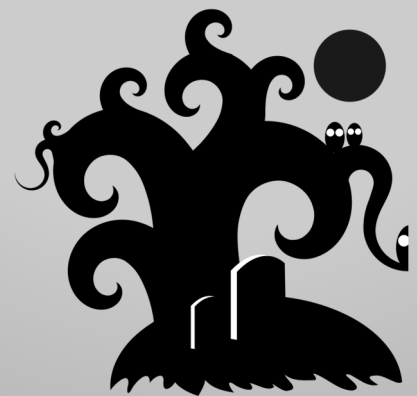
Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Bollman, Hales, & Reeve Farley attended. The minutes of the regular meeting held on September 11, 2018 were approved. 2nd & 3rd readings to By-Law No. 1598 (Riverdale Boundary Road Agmt) were given. Resolution No 2018-47 was upheld. Richmond Surveys was authorized to survey the gravel pile in Christie Pit and elevation work for Forrest Drainage. Authorization was given to rent a van to transport historical documents to Manitoba Archives in Winnipeg and for a Council member to transport said documents at \$25.00 per hour. Subscription for GeoTab GPS devices for graders was approved at a cost of \$199.00 per unit and \$32.00

monthly plus taxes. Revised Policy No. 29-2012 (Procurement) was approved. Organizational Chart for Elton Utility was approved as circulated. Chris Winthrop Enterprises Inc. was notified that award of work was cancelled on SW 9-11-18 Proposed drainage work by Wes Pankratz on NE 23-12-17 was approved. Staff overtime to September 30th, 2018 was approved. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$189,966.80. RFP specifications for 2019 Gravel Hauling were approved as revised. The meeting adjourned to Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 9:00 am.

- All payments received after 4:30 pm on Wednesday, October 31st, 2018, will be charged interest at 1.25% per month on the 1st day of each month, compounded annually at December 31st.

Warranty Expired on 2016-2017 Waterline Expansion Project
