Municipal Minutes

Regular Meeting Nov. 13, 2018

Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, Bromley and Reeve Farley attended. Each Council member took the Oath of Office, signed Declaration of Assets and Council Code of Conduct. Financial statement for the months ending September 30 and October 31, 2018 were filed. 1st reading was given to By-Law No. 1602 (Indemnity). Agreement was adopted and first reading of By-Law No. 1603 (Drainage Ditch Maintenance on SE ½ 31-11-18) was given. Authorization was given for additional costs to water tanker to Glendale Industries in the amount of \$1815.00 plus tax subject to RM of Cornwallis paying 50%. Conditional Use Order No. C-05-18-E (Phillips) for NE ¼ 19-12-18 was approved. Award of Douglas Berm elevations to Richmond Surveys in the amount of \$9,000.00 plus GST was ratified. Approval of clay capping of the south mile of Douglas Road due to the occurrence of favourable weather was ratified. Gravel Hauling was awarded to Bluestar Construction for the years 2019-2021 for wards 1-4 and

Fred Gilbert Trucking for wards 5-6. Policy No. 68-2018 (waterline repairs) was approved as presented. Authorization was given for a culvert inventory order due to expected increase in metal costs. Appointments for 2018/2019 committees were approved. RM of Elton logo and stationary was approved as presented. 2019 Emergency Plan and the 2019 Emergency Social Services Plan was approved as presented. MOU's with adjacent municipalities for support services is to be requested. Harvey Paterson or contractor were permitted to use Elton Lands for demolition of Forrest Grain Elevator. Approach on SW 11-11-17 for Demkey was approved with conditions. Staff overtime to October 31, 2018 was approved. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$2,620,636.27 as per list of accounts presented to Council. Meeting was adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, December 11, 2018 at 9:00 am or at the call of the Reeve.

Waterline Repairs

Policy No. 68-2018

POLICY DESCRIPTON: Being a policy to identify responsibility for waterline repairs within the Rural Municipality of Elton (Elton).

Responsibility of Elton:

Elton shall be responsible for:

- 1) Repairs and maintenance of all water pipes and devices on public property outside of private property lines. This includes such items as water mains, water main valves and curb stops.
- 2) Repair and/or replacement of the water meter and reader installed on private property.

Responsibility of Property Owner:

Following expiry of the warranty period after installation of the waterline, the property owner shall be responsible for:

- 1) all water pipes, equipment and connectors on private property after the curb stop, except the water meter and reader.
- 2) All costs for any lost water that is recorded through the water meter and reader.


