

### **POLICY DESCRIPTON:**

Whereas emergency situations within Elton's Rural Waterline System may occur;

And Whereas these emergency situations may occur beyond the control of the parameters and safety procedures set by the Provincial Office of Drinking Water and Whitehead Elton Regional Water Co-operative;

And Whereas Council of the Rural Municipality of Elton is responsible for notifying rural waterline consumers of any emergency situations;

Now Therefore be it resolved that Council of the Rural Municipality of Elton hereby enacts this policy as follows:

When an emergency situation within Elton's Rural Waterline System occurs, and waterline consumers need to be notified, one or more of the following notification processes will be used, as deemed necessary, based on the situation presented:

- Notifying residents by radio and Westman Communication Group with public service announcements and/or social media (website, Facebook, Elton newsletter and email).
- Residents will receive warnings by telephone if time and circumstances permit.
- Door - to - door contact if time and circumstances permit.
- Cellular broadcast through Manitoba EMO if emergency deems necessary.
