

POLICY DESCRIPTION:

Whereas the Rural Municipality of Elton recognizes that beavers build dams in waterways located within the Rural Municipality of Elton (Elton).

Whereas beavers or dams may need to be controlled or removed to protect lands and infrastructure.

Now therefore be it resolved that Council of the Rural Municipality of Elton hereby set the policy for removal of beaver dams as follows:

Elton: is responsible for coordination, removal and expenses relating to control or removal of beavers or dams that are causing damage or safety concerns to municipal infrastructure, when deemed necessary by the Councillor of the Ward.

- Elton will hire a trapper/hunter for beaver control as needed and further authorize payment per beaver at \$25.00 when taken in problem areas.
- Elton will pay for all costs associated with removal of beaver dams causing damage or safety concerns to municipal infrastructure.

Landowners: are responsible for coordination, removal and expenses relating to control or removal of beavers or dams that are impacting private lands.

Furthermore, any party dealing with controlling and/or removing of beavers or dams must be done in accordance with federal and provincial legislation.
