Building Inspector

With the assistance of HMC Management Inc, the Keystone Planning District (KPD) is seeking the services of an experienced Building Inspector to provide at a minimum Class 9 Building Inspection Services for KPD.

Ideally, you have broad knowledge of building construction, materials, and related codes and legislation. There is a need to be able to read detailed building plans. This knowledge is normally acquired through completion of a building technology course or completion of a journeyman's certificate in a related trade plus 5 years' experience of municipal inspection work or a similar capacity.

The incumbent must be eligible for membership in the Manitoba Building Officials Association and provide proof of a valid Manitoba class 5 driver's license.

Generally you are responsible for administering the Manitoba Building, Plumbing, Farm Building and Fire Code requirements, including processing building permit applications, completing related inspections, and providing information in response to public enquiries for the KPD partners.
