Municipal Minutes

August 13, 2019 Regular Meeting: Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, Bromley and Reeve Farley attended. Financial Statement for the month ended July 31, 2019 was accepted and filed. 3rd reading to BL 1616 (Max. Speed Limits) was given and passed. 2nd and 3rd reading to BL 1617 (Procedural) were given and passed. Drainage quotes were awarded to Quarry Hills for SW 26-12-18 in the amount of \$690.00, and Bluestar construction for NE 32-11-18 in the amount of \$2,400.00. Council approved entering into an agreement with Christie Organics and Gravel for gravel purchases on NE 27-13-19 for the years 2019, 2020 & 2021 at \$1.30/yd³. Additions/Deletions to taxes for properties as per the 2019 Assessor 326 (1) listing were approved. Support was registered for the RM of Stuartburns Resolution No. 186-19 for review of The Endangered Species Act and The Species at Risk Act to make amendments to ensure that private landowners can make a living off their land farming. Council authorized 2019 grant for DCRA in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the recreation reserve

subject to insurance concerns being addressed as a priority. Reimbursement of funds to D. Mazier was approved for planting trees on Heeney Ave. in the amount of \$1,135.50 (being a 50/50 cost share basis). Council approved temporary signage along municipal road allowance to determine interest in RFNow Fibre installation. Council to request Manitoba Infrastructure to replace two culverts in Justice along PR 468. Staff overtime to July 2019 was approved. Steele & Burdeniuk was approved to attend MMAA District Meeting on September 20, 2019. Elton to request technical and financial assistance from MWSB to conduct a study on the Forrest Lagoon to determine available loading capacity for additional service connections. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$367,2765.91 as per list of accounts presented to Council. Meeting adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 9:00 am or at the call of the Reeve.

PUBLIC NOTICE - BOARD OF REVISION FOR 2020 ASSESSMENTS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the 2020 assessment roll for the Rural Municipality of Elton has been deposited in the Municipal Office at Forrest, Manitoba, and is open for public inspection during regular business hours. Applications for revision may be made in accordance with sections 42 & 43 of the Assessment Act:

APPLICATION FOR REVISION

- 42(1) A person in whose name property has been assessed, a mortgagee in possession of property under section 114(1) of The Real Property Act, an occupier of premises who is required under the terms of a lease to pay the taxes on the property, or the assessor may make application for the revision of an assessment roll with respect to
- (a) liability to taxation;
 - (b) amount of assessed value;
 - (c) classification of property; or
 - (d) a refusal by an assessor to amend the assessment roll under subsection 13(2).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 43(1) An application for revision must
- (a) be made in writing;
 - (b) set out the roll number and legal description of the assessable property for which a revision is sought;
 - (c) state the grounds on which the application is based; and
 - (d) be filed by
 - (i) delivering it or causing it to be delivered to the office indicated in the public notice given under subsection 41(2); or
 - (ii) serving it upon the Secretary at least 15 days before the scheduled sitting date of the Board as indicated in the public notice.

The Board of Revision will sit on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 at 10:15 A.M. in the Council Chamber of the Rural Municipality of Elton to hear applications.

The final date on which applications must be received by the Secretary of the Board is Monday, September 23, 2019 at 4:30 P.M.
