## Municipal Minutes

**November 12, 2019 Regular Meeting:** Councillors Mitchell, Campbell, Paterson, Bollman, Hales, Bromley and Reeve Farley attended. Council agreed that if a ratepayer requests onsite fire protection for a controlled burn, all costs for fire protection will be the responsibility of the ratepayer. Financial statement for the month ended October 31, 2019 was accepted and filed. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings were given to BL 1618 (Christie Pit), 1<sup>st</sup> reading was given to BL 1619 (2020 Indemnity), & 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> readings were given to BL 1620 (Riverdale Fire Protection Agmt). Conditional Use C-01-19-E (McLaughlin) on NE 12-12-19 & Conditional Use No. C-02-19-E (Paterson) were approved. Council recessed and assembled as the Board of Revision. **Board of Revision Meeting November 12, 2019:** Board upheld the 2020 assessment for Appeal No. 2019-01 for Viterra, Roll 106950. The 2020 Personal and Real Property Assessment Rolls were adopted as submitted.

**Board adjourned; Council reassembled.** Payment for 2020 E911/Police Emergency Communications Annual Service Fee of \$5,609.31 (\$4.47 x 1273 population) was authorized. Appointments for 2019/2020 committees were approved. RFNow Inc. maps were approved for Fibre Optic installation. One additional recycling bin was approved for the Douglas Transfer Site. Extension for completion of landscaping on Lot 7, Plan 55511 in Forrest was authorized. Staff overtime to October 2019 was approved. Kathleen Steele was authorized to attend Subdivisions 101 in Brandon on Jan. 15, 2019. Accounts were approved in the amount of \$2,553,696.93 as per list of accounts circulated to Council. Meeting adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, December 10, 2019 or at the call of the Reeve.
