### COVID-19 Closures, Procedures and Precautions Notice #1

#### Closures

- Municipal Office – closed to the public. Request that all business transactions with Elton be done, if possible, via:

- Community Centres:
  - Douglas Community Centre
  - Elton Community Center
  - Justice Community Centre

#### Procedures

- Please notify our office if:
  - you are elderly and have no supports in place;
  - if you have a family member within Elton that is elderly that you are unable to assist/support.
- Forrest Water Truck Fill & Community Wells:
  - Remain open.
  - Request users to bring sanitizer or wipes to wipe down control panel before use.

#### Precautions

- Avoid physical contact with others such as handshakes.
- Practice proper hand washing procedures:
  - Running clean water over your hands;
  - Rubbing soap on your hands for 20 seconds including front and backs of hands and in-between fingers and thumbs;
  - Rinsing hands with clean water.
- Practice proper cough and sneeze etiquette:
  - Cover your mouth and nose with your arm to reduce the spread of germs;
  - If you use a tissue, dispose of it as soon as possible and wash your hands afterwards.
- Use social distancing in your day to day lives by keeping 2 metres distance whenever possible with others.
- Do not gather in groups of more than 50 people.
- Do not go out unless you have to.
- Disinfect surfaces multiple times throughout the day.
- If you feel ill, stay home and self-isolate and call the Health Links Info at 1-888-315-9257.
- If you have been out of the country, or been in contact with someone who has been out of the country stay home and self-isolate for 14 days.
- Avoid non-essential travel even within Canada.
